Calvary Bible College was founded in the year 1970 at Mussourie, Uttar Pradesh by Rev. Harry E. Scism through a vision from the Lord. It was named ‘Calvary Bible Institute’ just as it was revealed to him. In the year 1973 it was moved to Shillong, Meghalaya and Graduate in Theology (G.Th.) degree was offered at its initial stage. About 80% of the graduates from this institution are serving the Lord in fulltime ministry and they are useful instruments for the spreading of the Oneness truth. The institution was upgraded to B.Th. level in the year 2005 and the medium of learning was also changed from Mizo to English. Many of our B.Th. Graduates are also serving in the ministry now, some are working as missionaries in mission fields, some are working as pastors in various districts. Our heartfelt gratitude goes to our District leaders who have shown our graduates the areas where they could be working for God.

The 2014 Graduation Day was held on November 23, 2014(Sunday). **Rev. V.L. Dika Sailo, The General Superintendent, UPC North East India** was the Speaker on this special occasion.

Mission Expo & Practical ministry: The Mission Expo June 28 - July 11, 2014 for the Second year students and Practical ministry June 28 –July 6, 2014 for the final year was also a fruitful one. The second year students were sent to Assam and North Bengal Missions Fields. The Field Director Pastor Lalsiemlien Joute, and our missionaries guided our students. I am exceedingly thankful to them for their cooperation. The burden for the Mission fields which they came back with moved them to tears.

The final year students visited ASC Home at Khuangpuilam, Kolasib, Mizoram. Our students were involved in preaching, teaching in Sunday School, fellowship programmes, conducting devotional meetings and prayers. Apart from these, they were also involved in different physical works and activities. The Project Director Rev. Lalrinmawia has written to us expressing his gratitude to the College for sending them to the Home; telling us that the Home children and all the members of the community also received God's blessings through their ministry.

Spiritual Emphasis Week: The Spiritual Emphasis Week programme which was held from August 6-10 with the theme “**Ye are the light of the world**” was really a wonderful experience for all of us. The movement of the Holy Spirit was strongly felt during this week. Every one of us was freshly challenged to take new steps to light our world up.

CBC Day: For the second time, CBC Day was observed on September 8. Our students and staff donated blood in the name of CBC at NEIGRHIMS hospital. The hospital staff and doctors expressed their gratitude to our College.

Work Scholarship: For the first time, work scholarship was provided for students with financial difficulties to earn in order to aid their financial conditions.
