

CALVARY BIBLE COLLEGE: SHILLONG
ANNUAL REPORT 2015
(Reporting Period: February 4, 2015 – February 4, 2016)

Calvary Bible College was founded in the year 1970 at Mussourie, Uttar Pradesh by Rev. Harry E. Scism through a vision from the Lord. It was named 'Calvary Bible Institute' just as it was revealed to him. In the year 1973 it was moved to Shillong, Meghalaya and Graduate in Theology (G.Th.) degree was offered at its initial stage. About 80% of the graduates from this institution are serving the Lord in fulltime ministry and they are useful instruments for imparting of the Oneness truth. The institution was upgraded to B.Th. level in the year 2005 and the medium of learning was also changed from Mizo to English. It obtained its affiliation from Global Association of Theological Studies(GATS) on January 27, 2014. Many of our B.Th. Graduates are also serving in the ministry now, some are working as missionaries in mission fields, some are working as pastors in various districts. Our heartfelt gratitude goes to our District leaders who have shown our graduates the areas where they could be working for God.

First of all, I would like to highlight the report of CBC during this year in brief. CBC, under the guidance of God, has achieved a lot within this year, and of course also with the help of our great leaders here and all the members of United Pentecostal Church in North East India. I would like to thank the General Executive Board and the Theological Education Board, who at the General Conference Saiha, Chhimtuipui District allowed us to appeal for the construction of CBC Hall. The Construction for a hall was started and though it is not yet fully completed, it is to be inaugurated. This was made possible only by the generosity of our leaders and those individuals and the various departments.

Our gratitude also goes to the International Ladies Ministries, the General LAD, the General PYD and all the Districts in North East India for your financial backing and your prayer support for the running of CBC, without which we could not have achieved this much. I would like to make a special mention to the General LAD for collecting Rs. 10/- per member all over North East India and we hope that with this collection our College Library would develop further. God shows his abundant love to us through generous brothers and sisters in Christ, and it never stops. There are people and churches, which are generous enough to invest their riches in this Bible College by sponsoring our students, presenting us gifts for the upliftment of our college. We pray that God will repay them with showers of blessing. On behalf of CBC, I give thanks to you all.

CBC is now putting emphasis on Practical Ministry as far as it can. This year the Second Year students were sent to Kolkatta Missions Field where they gained a lot of insights and the Final years were sent to Tura Section, Central District and Orphanage Home at Kolasib. Apart from that we divided the students into five tutorial groups where we, the Lecturers, are the tutors, and these tutorial groups met according to their conveniences. During this year, as a tutorial group we had a successful Weekend Ministry where some group went to hospitals and had prayer ministry there, and some groups organized fasting prayers, distributing tracts and conducted home visits. The 2nd year students were also asked to involve in children ministry as Children Sunday School teachers which we found to be quite fruitful.

In Calvary Bible College, we emphasize baptism of the Holy Spirit, and we want each of our students to receive the Baptism of the Holy Ghost. Therefore I am pleased to share to you with a joyful heart that during this year some of our students have newly received the baptism of the Holy Ghost and two of our student who came from other denominations received water baptism in the name of Jesus. Praise the Lord! And what makes us so enthusiastic to share to you is that during this year, the Spiritual Promotional Cell of the College is buying a new Ampli-Speaker and other sound Systems. And the Student's Disciplinary Cell also donated plastic chairs and other materials to the College. We the teachers are proud to share to you that our students – past and present have the heart of giving and they are contributing a lot toward the development of the college.

This year CBC organized a successful Spiritual Emphasis Week where we were blessed with the powerful messages from our teachers, the experience of spiritual blessings through our singing, group discussion, and inspiring paper presentations, Bible studies and also prayers. As our theme this year was “Know Your Spiritual Adversary”, all of us were interested and we had discussions about it during and in between the programmes.

For the third time in CBC history, CBC Day was observed on September 8. Our students and staff donated blood in the name of CBC at NEIGRHIMS. The hospital staff and doctors expressed their gratitude to our College and handed to us a trophy and a certificate in the name of Calvary Bible College.

The 2015 Graduation Day was held on November 28-29, 2015. **Rev. Lalmalsawma Sailo, The General Superintendent, UPC North East India, Rev. R. Lalrinsanga, The General Secretary, UPC North East India and Rev. Pantsa Leyri, District Superintendent, South East Nagaland District (SEND)** were the Speakers on this special occasion.
